1. Ph.D. scholarships:

- Duration of the scholarship: max. 9 months
- Value of the scholarship: € 940.- / month

2. Post-Doc scholarships:

- Duration of the scholarship: max. 7 months
- Value of the scholarship: € 1,310.- / month

Eligible Fields of Study / Research:

Applications are accepted for all branches of

- Technical Sciences
- Natural Sciences
- Medicine
- Agricultural Science
- Environmental Studies
- Economic Sciences (including Tourism Research)
- Humanities and Social Sciences
- Arts and Music

Requirements for Application:

Ph.D. applicants:

- enrollment for Ph.D. studies at a Chinese / Taiwanese member institution of Eurasia-Pacific Uninet
- high scientific and artistic quality on an international level
- having a supervisor at the home institution
- very good command of spoken and written English or German.

Post-Doc applicants:

- Ph.D. degree
- high scientific and artistic quality on an international level
- very good command of spoken and written English or German
- position on academic staff of a member institution of Eurasia-Pacific Uninet.

There is no age limit set for Ph.D. or Post-Doc applicants!

Further requirements:

Statement of acceptance by a university professor of an Austrian member institution, acting as host and supervisor.

The Universities are asked to **pre-select the best qualified candidates** and to:

- **nominate applicants** (Ph.D. and Post-Doc)
- **forward the completed application documents to the Eurasia-Pacific Uninet Office in Salzburg.**

The final selection of Ph.D. and Post-Doc scholarship-holders will be made by a joint committee of professors /scientists from Austria.

The Austrian Academic Exchange Service (ÖAD) is in charge of the practical administration of the Eurasia-Pacific Uninet scholarship, which includes

- **monthly pay-out** of the scholarship **after candidate's arrival in Austria**
- providing of **accommodation** (on request of scholarship-holder)
- **health insurance** for the period of stay in Austria.
