- Wide variety of topics, including wildlife, fisheries, range, recreation, water, and timber.
- Field schools are an integral part of the forestry programs.
- Upon graduation students from this program can apply to become Registered Professional Foresters.

- Operations that maximize economic returns and minimize environmental impact

Forest Sciences



- Focus: Scientific principles related to the growth and development of forest organisms, and the ecology of plant and animal communities.
- Students select an area of concentration during their second year
 - Genetics, ecology, entomology, pathology, silviculture, and fire science.
 - **International Specialization:** forest ecosystems in another part of the world.

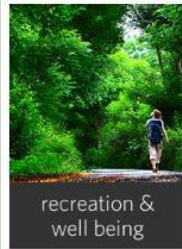

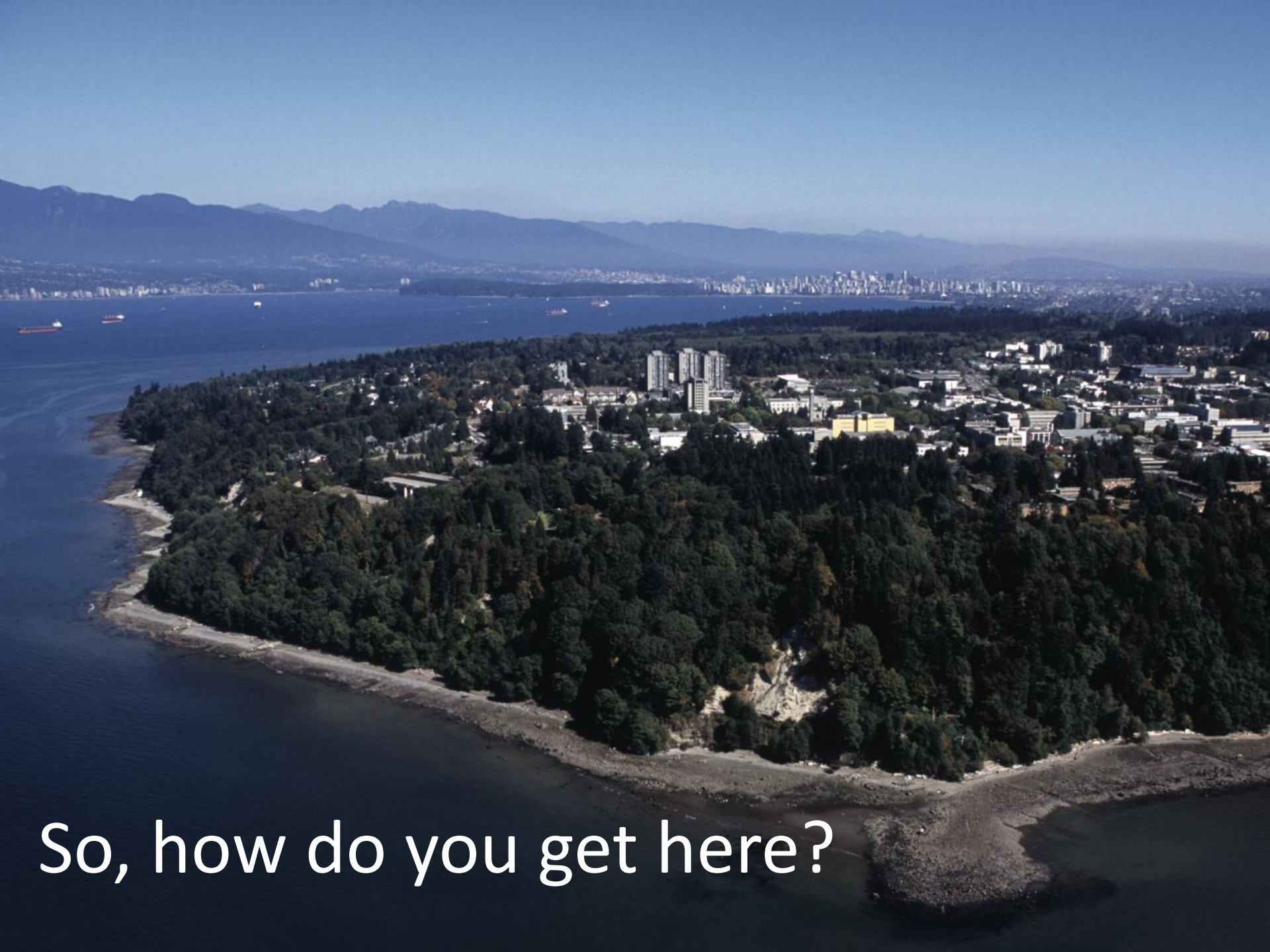

How to Apply

1. Apply online and pay the fee

- Visit **you.ubc.ca** to apply
- Always use your **official name** (as it appears on your official documents i.e. birth certificate, passport, etc.);
- Pay the application fee.
 - Pay when you apply or
 - Pay after you have submitted your application by logging into the Student Service Centre and selecting “my Financial Account”

Applications **will not be processed** until the application fee has been received by UBC

How to Apply cont'd

2. Receive student number and email acknowledgement

After submitting

- You will instantly receive a **UBC student number** to confirm receipt of your application;
- You will receive an acknowledgment letter confirming your UBC number and listing the documents needed in order to process your file;

Awards for Domestic Students

Centennial Scholars Entrance Awards

The Centennial Scholars Entrance Award supports academically qualified students who show an interest in joining the UBC community, but would not be able to attend university without significant financial assistance. 100 awards range from \$4,000 one-time awards to renewable awards of approximately \$20,000 per year.

Presidential Scholars Awards

Presidential Scholars Awards are competitive one-time and renewable scholarships to students entering directly from high school. These scholarships recognize students who excel across the board and who have demonstrated academic and leadership achievements in the arts, community, athletics, and school. Up to 150 one-time and renewable awards of up to \$20,000 per year are available.

No application is required; students who submit their admissions application by December 1st are automatically considered for these competitive scholarships.

How to Apply for Housing

- 20 Summer & Winter Session Housing- **Not** Year Round Housing
- Winter Session Residence—September to April
- Summer Residence— May to August
- **apply** no later than **May 1** and **accept** your offer of admission to UBC no later than **June 1**.
- Should apply **both** Winter and Summer session, otherwise Housing will not provide living place for the gap between
 - w/o winter session, summer session move out – mid Aug

English Language Requirement

UBC accepts different tests of English language proficiency that evaluate skills in listening, reading, speaking and writing. The most commonly submitted are the **Test of English as a Foreign-Language (TOEFL)** and the **International English Language Testing System (IELTS)**.

TOEFL

- UBC institution code is **0965**
- Internet-based test: overall **90/120**
minimum part score **21 (writing and speaking)** and **22 (reading and Listening)**

IELTS

- Minimum score: an average of **6.5** with **no part less than 6.0**
