THE REGULATION
on the intercultural online forum
«Student's Vision of the World»

1. General regulations

- 1.1. This Regulation defines the purpose and objectives, as well as the procedure for conducting the Intercultural Online Forum "**Student's Vision of the World**" (hereinafter referred to as The Forum), the categories of its participants, and the main directions of The Forum programs.
- 1.2. The Forum is organized by the International Relations Department of Omsk State Agrarian University named after P.A. Stolypin (Omsk, Russia)
- 1.3. Students of colleges and higher educational institutions, citizens of the Russian Federation, citizens of other countries, as well as stateless persons can take part in The Forum.
- 1.4. Materials that correspond to the topics of The Forum are allowed to participate in.
- 1.5. All materials must be performed in accordance with the specified Criteria for each of the Forum's programs.
- 1.6. The language of The Forum is English.

2. Goals and objectives

- 2.1. Goal: creating a digital space for intercultural exchange, expanding student life and developing joint international projects.
- 2.2. Objectives of The Forum:
 - development of projects with participation of Russian and foreign students;
 - shaping an understanding of the values of the 21st century;



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- exchange of ideas on the impact of digital technologies on the lives of today's youth;
- formation of ideas about the cultural, scientific and sports life of modern youth.

3. The venue and dates of The Forum

- 3.1. The Forum is held on the social network Facebook <https://www.facebook.com/groups/svworld>.
- 3.2. Applications submitted no later than **December 12, 2021** are accepted for participation in The Forum.
- 3.3. The Forum results will be announced **after December 17, 2021** and published on The Forum's Facebook page.

4. Directions of The Forum

- 4.1. The Forum includes the implementation of the following three programs: *«Values of the 21st Century», «Youth Life in the Digitalized World», «Youth. Culture. Science. Sport».*
- 4.2. Values of the 21st Century. The aim of this topic is to present the visions of students from different universities and countries on the values of the 21st century. To participate in the discussion audio-records on the format of podcasts are accepted. The records should meet the following requirements:
- The audio should be recorded in English;
 - The text should correspond to the topic “Values of the 21st Century”;
 - It should not exceed 5 minutes;
 - No backgrounds sound should be heard.
 - It is also necessary to send us the transcript of the audio-recording when submitting the application.
- 4.3. Youth Life in the Digitalized World. This topic is devoted to the discussion of the impact of digital technologies on the lives of today's youth. To participate



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in the discussion on this topic only essay can be accepted. The requirements to the essay:

- it should be written in English;
- the volume of the essay should be 250-350 words;
- it can reveal positive and/or negative effects of digital technologies on youth life; talk about the use of digital technologies in life, education, work; describe such phenomena as Digital Detox, IoT, creation of online communities, etc.; talk about the prospects for the use of digital technologies in various spheres of life or any other issues related to the topic “Youth Life in the Digitalized World”.

4.4. Youth. Culture. Science. Sport. To participate in the Forum within the framework of this topic, participants should record a short video no more than 3 minutes showing the cultural, scientific and / or sports life at their university, youth or sports association, other organization engaged in scientific, sports or cultural activities. Language of the video should be English. If the video is recorded in a language other than English, it is necessary to use English subtitles.

5. To participate in The Forum, please:

- 5.1. Carefully read the current Regulation.
- 5.2. Prepare material for participation in The Forum.
- 5.3. Fill out the online form <https://forms.gle/y838N7ioDBdeJ3Jr7> or send materials for participation in the forum to our e-mail svworld2020@gmail.com along with the name of the participant(s), country of residence, university where the students are studying, course and field of study, contact email address(es).
- 5.4. *Submitting an application means that The Forum participants fully agree to the rules of The Forum set out in this Regulation.*

6. Rules for participation in The Forum



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- 6.1. Fill out the registration form or send materials along with the requested data by e-mail.
- 6.2. Students can participate in the forum simultaneously on several topics.
- 6.3. To participate in the activities of the Forum on each topic, the participants must mark them in the Registration form or indicate it in an e-mail and attach the relevant material.
- 6.4. The participants are responsible for the correctness of the filled personal data.
Please make sure that your full name, email address, and other information specified in the Registration form or when sending e-mails is correct in order to avoid possible errors when filling out and sending your diplomas by The Forum organizers.
- 6.5. Materials for participation in the Forum and the participant's Registration form must be submitted **by December 12, 2021**.
- 6.6. If the Forum participants have not submitted the data specified in the **clause 5.3** of this Regulation or submitted all the necessary information later than December 12, 2021, their materials will not be considered. *Forum participants are responsible for timely submission of materials for participation in the Forum.*
- 6.7. Materials for the Forum sent by e-mail without completed participant information or do not meet the criteria will not be considered.
- 6.8. If the links specified in the online Registration form do not open or the download of materials is impossible, the application for participation in the Forum will not be considered.
- 6.9. Materials approved by The Forum organizers will be published in the Facebook group: <https://www.facebook.com/groups/svworld>.

7. Evaluation of materials

- 7.1. Materials submitted for participation in The Forum are evaluated by The Forum organizers separately for each category.



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7.2. If the received materials meet the criteria, the organizers post them on the Forum's Facebook page, indicating the participant's personal data (full name of the participant(s), name of the educational institution, country and city of origin).

7.3. The results of the Forum are conducted based on the degree of involvement of the forum participants in the discussion of the material proposed on the forum page (essays, videos, podcasts).

7.4. The degree of involvement is determined by counting the total number of comments, as well as likes and shares of the material submitted to the Forum.

8. Summarizing. Rewarding

8.1. All participants of the Forum will receive certificates

8.2. Authors of essays, videos and podcasts that attract the most audience attention will be awarded with diplomas separately for each category.

8.3. The most active participants of the Forum will also receive diplomas.

8.4. The results of the Forum will be published on the official Facebook page.
